**ORDER**

Whereas, the District Disaster Management Authority (DDMA), Goalpara has vide order No. DDMA/Goalpara/37/2020/257-260 -(A) Dated 21-06-2021 issued consolidated and revised guidelines for the district of Goalpara for containment of COVID - 19 in both rural and urban areas until further order.

Whereas, the situation of COVID 19 in the District has been reviewed and observed that, though the number of COVID 19 patients and positivity rate is declining, the situation is still precarious, for which adequate containment measures for both urban and rural areas are still necessary for containment COVID-19 across the District.

Therefore in exercise of the powers, conferred under section 30 (2) (IV), (2) & (2) (XXIX) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005; I, the Deputy Commissioner cum Chairman, District Disaster Management Authority (DDMA), Goalpara, hereby issue the following directives which will be applicable in (both urban and rural areas) which will remain in force with effect from **5 AM of June 28, 2021 until further order.**

**A. Containment Zones :**

In case of test positivity of COVID-19 in any area reaches more than 10 cases in the last seven days the said area will be notified as containment zones following due procedure.

However, in such Zones, emergency services will continue round the clock and essential services including shops, dealing with groceries, fruits and vegetables, dairy and milk booths, animal fodder, etc. will remain open up to 5 pm.

Delivery of all essential goods including food, pharmaceuticals, medical equipment through e-commerce in such areas will continue round the clock.

**B. Restrictions imposed:**

**Except for exemptions given in Annexure 'A' ,**

1. The Curfew time will effective on round the clock in the District until further order.
2. Opening of work place and business/commercial establishments remain closed round the clock.
3. Functioning of Govt. and private offices/ establishments remain closed.
4. Opening of Shops and commercial establishments remain closed.
5. Shops dealing with groceries, fruits and vegetables, dairy and milk booths, animal fodder will remain open up to 5 PM. However, considering the present scenario of the district, these shops are permitted to open on either side of the road (excluding shops operating in isolated places) in alternate days and the identified fish/vegetable markets where mass gathering occurs will remain closed.
