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ORDER

Whereas, the District Disaster Management Authority (DDMA), Goalpara has vide order No. DDMA/Goalpara/37/2020/Pt.I/301-331 - (A) Dated: 26/10/2021 issued consolidated and revised guidelines for the district of Goalpara for containment of COVID - 19 in both rural and urban areas until further order.

Whereas, the situation of COVID 19 in the District has been reviewed and observed that, though the number of COVID 19 patients and positivity rate is declining, the situation is still precarious, for which adequate containment measures for both urban and rural areas are still necessary for containment COVID-19 across the District.

Whereas, the situation of COVID-19 in the State has been further reviewed and the overall case load and positively rate are declining steadily.

Whereas, the District Disaster Management Authority (DDMA), Goalpara has vide order of August,17, 2021 under Clause (C-5) further relaxed the directives for women employees having children to work from home by reducing the age of children to 3 years.

Whereas, the District Disaster Management Authority (DDMA), Goalpara has further vide order of October, 26, 2021 under clause (C-1) issued directives for government servants (including contractual and fixed pay) who have taken at least one dose of COVID-19 vaccine to attend office, except those in whose case vaccination is contra-indicated as per guidelines issued by the Health Department of Government of Assam and / or such claim is certified by a registered medical practitioner to get themselves vaccinated and attend office.

Whereas, gatherings in enclosed spaces without prior social distancing and maintenance of the COVID-19 protocols runs the risk of spread of Corona virus and may also give rise to serious difficulties in contact tracing, thereby adversely affecting containment of the spread of COVID-19.

Whereas, it is necessary to formulate norms of public gathering during the forthcoming major festivals in the state in order to ensure that people are able to celebrate these festivals with joy gusto, while at the same time adhering to extant COVID-19 protocols.

Therefore in exercise of the powers, conferred under section 30 (2) (IV), (2) & (2) (XXIX) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 and order from CEO, ASDMA vide order no. ASDMA.28/2021/326 Dated: 12th November, 2021, I, the Deputy Commissioner cum Chairman, District Disaster Management Authority (DDMA), Goalpara, considering the present COVID-19 situation of the district, hereby issue the following directives which will be applicable in both urban and rural areas which will remain in force with immediate effect.

1. The relaxation issued for pregnant women employees and women employees with children of 3 years or below working under any Government / PSU / Financial Institutions / Private Organizations shall stand withdraw.
2. All Government servants (including contractual and fixed pay) except those on authorized leave shall attend office.

Other directives issued vide No. DDMA/Goalpara/37/2020/Pt.I/301-331 (A) Dated: 26th October, 2021 shall remain in force until further order.
