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ORDER

Whereas, it has been observed that with unabated inter-district movement, the COVID-19 containment measures are not yielding the desired level of reduction in COVID-19 cases.

Therefore, in partial modifications of clause D (3) of the Order issued vide Order No. DDMA/Goalpara/37/2020/180-183 dated 04/05/2021 and clarification Clause A (8) issued vide Order No. DDMA/Goalpara/37/2020/204-206 dated 13/05/2021 allowing inter-state/intra-state movement and in exercise of the powers conferred upon me section 30(2)(iv),(2) (v) & (2) (xxix) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, I Smt. Varnali Deka, IAS, Deputy Commissioner cum Chairperson, District Disaster Management Authority (DDMA), Goalpara keeping in view of the emergent nature of the situation, hereby issue the following directives shall come into force with effect from **5 AM of May, 21, 2021**.

All inter district transport services and movement of people to and from other districts shall remain suspended for 15 days with effect from **5 AM of May, 21, 2021 (Friday)** or until further order except exemptions as specified below :


1. Movement of Goods and persons including frontline workers in connection with COVID-19 related duties on production of valid documents.
2. Movement of Officials and persons, both government & private involved in **emergency services** such as :
 - I) Health & Family Welfare and all related medical establishments,
 - II) Police,
 - III) Prisons,
 - IV) Home Guards,
 - V) Civil Defence,
 - VI) Fire & Emergency Services,
 - VII) District Administration,
 - VIII) Pay & Accounts office,
 - IX) Electricity,
 - X) Water & Sanitation,
 - XI) Public Transport (Air/Railways/Buses) including all incidental services/activities that are essential for smooth functioning of all modes of public transport
 - XII) Disaster Management & related services,
 - XIII) Indian Meteorological Department,
 - XIV) Central Water Commission,
 - XV) Water Resources Department,
 - XVI) Public Health Engineering,
 - XVII) National Informatics Centre,
 - XVIII) National Cadet Corps
 - XIX) Municipal services and

All other essential services on production of valid Identity card.

3. Movement of Judicial Officers/ Officials of District Courts on production of valid identity card.
4. Movement of Pregnant women and patients for getting medical/ health services.
5. Movement of Person coming from / going to Airports / Railway Stations / ISBTs allowed to travel on production of valid tickets.
6. Movement of Officers/Officials related to functioning of offices of Diplomats of various countries as well as persons holding any constitutional post on production of valid identity card.
7. Movement of Electronic and Print Media & Government servants handling media issues on production of valid identity card.
8. There shall be no restrictions on inter-state and intra-state movement / transportation of essential / non-essential goods. No separate permission/ e-pass will be required for such movements.
9. Movement of persons related to commercial and private establishments providing following essential services / commodities shall be allowed :
 - I) Shops dealing with Food, groceries, fruits and vegetables , dairy and milk booths, meat & Fish, Animal fodder, pharmaceuticals, medicines and medical equipment.
 - II) Banks, insurance offices and ATMs.
 - III) Telecommunications, Internet services, Broadcasting and Cable services, IT & IT enabled services.
 - IV) Delivery of all essential goods including Food, pharmaceuticals, medical equipment through e-commerce.
 - V) Petrol pumps, LPG, CNG, Petroleum & Gas, retail and storage outlets.
 - VI) Power generation, transmission and distribution units and services.
 - VII) Cold storage and warehousing services.
 - VIII) Private security services.
 - IX) Manufacturing units of essential commodities.
 - X) Production units or services, which require continuous processes.
10. Movement of Person who are going for Covid-19 vaccination.
11. Movement of all the Officials / Persons entrusted with Election related works either by Govt. authorities or by private enterprises or by the authorities of any political party or contesting candidate on production of a valid identity card / engagement letter / appointment letter / work order.
12. Movement of all the employees/ persons involve in operations related to Forestry under the environment & forest department on production of valid identity card.
13. Movement related to supply and maintenance of Agricultural implements.
14. Movement related to essential items supply from and to FCI establishments.
15. Transportation of all medical personnel, nurses, paramedical staff, other hospital support services.

16. Movement of Air traffic, Railway passenger, and goods trains shall continue to operate.
17. Movement of Government /Semi Government officers and senior executives in Non-Government sector along with their key support staff for emergency and essential works.
18. Movement in connection with maintaining supply chain of medicines.
19. Movement of goods shall continue uninterrupted.
20. Movement related to vehicle, last rite emergencies or any other movement with written permission from the District Administration.


Other restrictions and exemptions therefrom as notified vide Order No. DDMA/Goalpara/37/2020/180-183 dated 04/05/2021 for rural areas and vide Order No. DDMA/Goalpara/37/2020/198-200 dated 12/05/2021 and vide Order No. DDMA/Goalpara/37/2020/208 dated 15/05/2021 for Urban and peripheral areas and clarification issued vide Order No. DDMA/Goalpara/37/2020/204-206 dated 13/05/2021 shall continue to remain in force.
