

NOTICE INVITING TENDER FOR SETTLEMENT OF COUNTRY SPIRIT SHOPS OF GOALPARA DISTRICT BY AUCTION THROUGH SEALED TENDERS FOR THE TERM COMMENCING from 1st April, 2016 to 31st March 2019

Notice is hereby given for information of the intending tenders, that the licences for the under mentioned Country Spirit Shops shall be settled by auction through sealed tender system for the term commencing from 1st April, 2016 to 31st March, 2019 at the office of the Deputy Commissioner cum Collector Goalpara district on 4th Feb, 2016 at 11.00 A.M. subject to the following conditions.



- I. The licence settled will give the right of opening only at the sites within 100 yards thereof, as may be approved by Government, provided that the State government reserve to itself the right in case of combination of other cause to transfer, before settlement, any shop from locality specified to some other locality.
- II. Each licence shall be settled by auction through sealed tender with the tenderer offering the maximum vend free for the particular Country Spirit Shops as per Assam Excise (Amendment) Rules, 2006.
- III. The Advisory Committee shall reserve the right to recommend the tenderer offering the maximum vend free for settlement and shall exercise the same, after due consideration of viability and Reasonableness of such offer in terms of Vend fees of previous term, sale effected and profit made in respect of the particular shop.
- IV. In respect of a tie in the quoted rate of vend fees or any other matter, during consideration of the settlement of any Country Spirit Shops by auction through sealed tender, the settlement, shall be made by lottery.
- V. Sealed tenders quoting the rate of vend free per LPL alongwith other details as per prescribed format of the tender, shall be received by the Deputy Commissioner cum Collector of Goalpara District in between 11 hours and 13.50 hours on 19th Dec, 2015 in his office. The tender forms shall be available at the office of the Superintendent of Excise, Goalpara during office hours free of cost.
- VI. Each tender shall bear court fee stamp of Rs. 24.75 (Rupees Twenty Four and paisa Seventy Five) only.
- VII. The undersigned is not bound to accept any particular tender.
- VIII. Any shop not settled on the day fixed due to any reason shall be resettled by the same system on subsequent date to be duly notified.
- IX. (a) A person with whom a country spirit shop is settled on auction through sealed Tender, the settlement holder shall be required to deposit as security a sum equivalent to 15 days vend fees at the quoted rate of vend fee offered by him on the estimated consumption during the equal number of days of the particular country Spirit Shop in the previous term, on the day, on which the result of auction through sealed tender is announced.

(b) The purchaser is liable for any loss that may accrue to Govt. in case it become necessary to re-auction the shop at a lower rate of vend fee on his failure to pay the security money on the date of auction result of the Country Spirit Shop.
- X. If for any valid reason, a licence after its settlement through auction be refused to the purchaser the security money shall be refunded.
- XI. The term of settlement of Country Spirit Shops by auction sealed tendered shall remain valid with from 1st April, 2016 to 31st March, 2019 subject to renewal after every financial year with 6% (six percent) increase in the vend fee at which the shop is settled by auction through sealed tender, provided the performances of the lessee is found satisfactory.

- XII. In case of submission of any false data by the Tenderer in his tender the settlement of any shop made in his favour shall be liable to be cancelled forthwith.
- XIII. As per rule 223 Sub rule 1 of the Assam Excise Rules, 1945 a minimum quota of Country Spirit Shop is kept reserved for Schedule Cast^e and Schedule Tribe candidate as shown in the list annexed herewith.
- XIV. Minimum age of tenderer must be 21 years on the date of commencement of the term for which he or she has tendered, however there is no upper age limit.
- XV. It is not at present intended to open any other shop within a radius of 5Kms. Of the licenced shops during the term of the licence, but the state Government may for any valid reason increase the number of shops. Such shops on such increase shall be settled under the rules in force and the licencees within a radius of 5 Kms of such new shops shall not have any preference in the matter of settlement. However , such licencees may surrender his licence without forfeiting his security.
- XVI. The term of the licence will commence on the 1st day of April and the purchaser is required to open the shop on the day in which the term of his licence commences or on such date as the Deputy Commissioner cum Collector of the district, may order, falling which the security paid by him shall be forfeited and the licence shall be cancelled and resettled at the defaulter's risk and he shall be liable for any loss that may accrue to Govt. by such resettlement through the same system.
- XVII. The settlement of all shops shall be subject to express condition that the licencee shall be personally responsible for its working and proper functioning.
- XVIII. In the currency of the licence as a result of the operation of temperance or otherwise if any shop closed at any time, the licencee shall not be entitled to any compensation on that count.
- XIX. The rate of Excise duty cost price etc. are liable to be altered anytime during the currency of the licence.
- XX. The licencee shall pay annual fees at the prescribed rate as prescribed under the rule, before commencement of the relevant year.
- XXI. All settlement holders must keep adequate stock in the respective Country Spirit Shops throughout the currency of the licence and also maintain a minimum stock as prescribed by the authority under rule 296 of the Assam Excise Rules ,1945
- XXII. Each tender shall be for a single country Spirit Shop but any person may submit separate tenders for any number of Country Spirit Shops. Provisions of Rule 206 of the Assam Excise Rules, 1945 shall apply mutas mutandi in respect of the tenders for auctions through sealed tenders.
- XXIII. All the relevant provisions of the Assam Excise, Acts and Rules made there under are binding on the settlement holders.
